Wild and Scenic Film Festival

Showings begin Thursday night

The South Yuba River Citizens League (SYRCL) will host the 16th annual Wild & Scenic Film Festival on Jan. 11-15 — drawing top filmmakers, activists, social innovators and world adventurers to the historic downtowns of Nevada City and Grass Valley. This year's festival theme is Groundswell and the goal is to inspire and unite communities to help heal the Earth. Over the course of five days and at 10 venues, more than 125 of the world's premiere environmental and adventure films will screen alongside activist workshops, panels, music, art exhibitions, and special guest and filmmaker appearances.
