Wild & Scenic On Tour School Program 6-8 Curriculum Overview

Program Theme: Resilient Communities

Module 1: Nature for All

Accompanying Film: Wood Hood & Reclaim Your Water

Description: Students will begin this multi-day lesson by reflecting on their own experiences in nature and the impact it had on them. Learners will then explore sources introducing multiple perspectives from BIPOC individuals in outdoor spaces. They will then participate in a Socratic seminar discussion about these complicated topics.

Module 2: Fire Ecology

Accompanying Film: Big Basin Speaks & Giant Sequoias - Yosemite

Description: Students will investigate the ecological significance of fire through a dendrochronology activity, exploring fire dependent species, and examining forest management practices.
